

## Glossary of Terms

While we try to keep it simple, we use a couple of key phrases quite a bit when speaking about the Be Connected Network. Here is a quick glossary of those terms.

**Network Partner** is a community organisation who is a member of the Be Connected Network

**Learners** are the people being supported to learn new digital skills through the Be Connected program (you may call them members, clients, students)

**Digital Mentors** are those in community organisations supporting people to access the Be Connected program (you may call them volunteers, staff, tutors, peers)

**Be Connected Network** is all the community organisations around the country who have signed up to run digital literacy activities for older Australians through the Be Connected program.

**Good Things Foundation** is the organisation that coordinates the Be Connected Network

**Be Connected Learning Portal** ([beconnected.esafety.gov.au](http://beconnected.esafety.gov.au)) is where your learners can go to complete the online digital skills courses.
